OLD BUSINESS:


- 1) The replacement of the sewer line under the canal bed is done.
- 2) More cleaning is needed to the property that burned at corner of Monroe and Wilson. The mayor will send a letter this week to the owners. There were some questions as to how to make the owners comply and Kurtis Fouts reported that there are remedies to the situation.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) There will be an announcement of the new police chief on May 4th in the council room at the City Building.
- 2) Question arose on how to handle the unsafe building owned by the railroad. The process is to cite them for the problem.

- 3) A list of 29 properties with violations of our weed and high grass ordinance. The Mayor reported that letters would go out on the 6th of May.
- 4) A sweeper needs to be purchased for the City Building. The Board of Works approved the purchase with a dollar limit of \$300.00.
- 5) Dick Daniels will retire the end of May 2010. Aaron has placed an ad in the paper for an employee. The applicant must have a CDL license.
