Mayor Evans called the meeting to order at 9 a.m. All members were in attendance.




The Board reviewed the 2019 budget and discussed desired items to be purchased with the budget. The Board discussed the walking trail at Riley Park which was included in the budget. The Board discussed new banners to replace aging and fading banners as well as pricing seasonal banners. The Board discussed possibilities for improving the viaduct to make it more attractive and welcoming. The Board discussed ways in which to encourage people to put out more Christmas lights and that the Greater Delphi Chamber had done a trolley tour in the past to see the decorations in town. The Board discussed the façade grant and properties which could benefit from the grant. Mayor Evans will get with Councilman Traeger to put together letters to send out to property owners with information regarding the façade grant. The Board expressed a desire for art installations around the downtown. The Board discussed requesting a line item for downtown beautification for the 2020 budget. The Board discussed requesting a line item for a marketing director for the 2020 budget. The Board expressed a desire to purchase more benches and trash cans for the downtown, a need to list the City Building repairs/maintenance that should be done in 2019, and a plan for Community Crossings in 2019.


More volunteers are needed to help water flowers in 2019.
