Mayor Anita Werling opened the meeting at 5:15 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Leanne Aldrich called the roll. Present were Spencer Kingery, Breanna Maxwell, and Mayor Werling.

Minutes of the May 1, 2023 regular meeting were presented for review. Spencer Kingery moved to approve. Second by Breanna Maxwell. Without objection, the minutes were approved as read.

Claims totaling \$448,625.40 were presented. Spencer Kingery moved to approve the claims. Second by Breanna Maxwell. No questions were asked. Motion carried. (3-0)

New Business

On behalf of the Delphi Opera House Joe Mayfield requested permission to block off parking on June 16 from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for a Cruise-In on the Courthouse side of the Square. Forty cars are expected and would require 1.5 spaces per vehicle. Cars would arrive around 4:00 p.m.; any unused spaces would be freed and signs removed after 5:00 p.m. Washington Street would be utilized first, followed by Franklin Street. Spencer Kingery asked that businesses be notified along with the Street department. Spencer Kingery moved to approve the request. Second by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried. (3-0)
