

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

July 1, 2024 – 5:30PM

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Spencer Kingery, Breanna Maxwell, and Mayor Yates.

The minutes of the June 17<sup>th</sup> meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve by Spencer Kingery second by Breanna Maxwell. Minutes were approved as read and carried. (3-0)

The next order of business were regular claims for July 1, 2024 totaling \$1,155,856.74. Motion to accept the claims made by Spencer Kingery, second by Breanna Maxwell. Spencer Kingery stated the amount being higher due to 3 large payments. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)




