

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING  
October 7, 2024 – 5:30PM

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Spencer Kingery, Breanna Maxwell, and Mayor Yates.

The minutes of the September 16<sup>th</sup> meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve minutes as read by Spencer Kingery second by Breanna Maxwell. Minutes were approved as read and carried. (3-0)

The next order of business were regular claims for September 16, 2024 totaling \$1,126,042.68. Motion to accept the claims made by Spencer Kingery, second by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Other Business:

The YWCA along with Mayor Yates and Clerk/treasurer Price read a breast cancer/domestic violence proclamation to declare October Domestic Violence and Breast Cancer awareness month.

Chief LaMar presented information for request for LESO application which would give the Delphi PD the ability to use the grant money for military surplus for extra trail equipment. Motion to grant request made by Breanna Maxwell, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Unfinished Business:

JT Doane presented the trunk or treat dates for Delphi Main Street. The date is October 26<sup>th</sup> from 4-6 with 30 confirmed trunks. It will be located at the park. After the trunk or treat will be a movie at dusk. Trunk or treat will include games, activities, crafts, etc. Motion to approve the date and time for trunk or treat made by Breanna Maxwell, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. Proposal from FOX 59 for a satellite truck to be parked on West Main St. for the Richard Allen trial. Ruth Ann Borden from FOX 59 presented that the news crew would like to have 1 parking space for at least 1 week, possibly the duration of the trial. The board discussed having the 3 satellite trucks parked in the first three spaces to avoid any issues. Chief LaMar stated the hard date for the spots would begin Oct. 17<sup>th</sup>- end of trial. Motion to approve the parking for the satellite trucks made by Breanna Maxwell with stipulation that the dates for the parking could be amended. Seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Proposal for WISH TV for a satellite truck placement on Main Street for the Richard Allen trial. Motion to grant permission for satellite truck for the duration of the trial made by Breanna Maxwell, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Dumpster placement request presented for approval by Mayor Yates for 224 N. Wilson St. for 2 weeks. Motion to approve dumpster placement made by Breanna Maxwell, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)




