

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Mayor Yates, Breanna Maxwell, and Spencer Kingery.

Other Business:

The board was presented with a request for placement of a temporary food truck for Paretta's Restorante possibly through the month of April for a few days throughout the week to get their menu items out to the public. Motion to present approval request for a food truck permit made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Breanna Maxwell. After the motion, discussion of 2-3 possible parking spots being used in front of the business or possibly the alley way with a clause included in the permitting request to revisit by April 7 for time constraints and the ability to renew the permit if needed. Mr. Jicha has the proper documentation, permit application, insurance, schedule of dates of operation, menu items, and liability policies and has forwarded them to the Clerk's office. Mayor Yates agreed that the parking spots in question will be monitored for any issues. Spencer Kingery added that he does not see an issue with granting a temporary permit because it would not be any different than someone requesting to put scaffolding or dumpsters in parking spots for a set amount of days/weeks for renovations to businesses. The board agreed that it would be important to help get the business up and running and off the ground to present it to the citizens before their official opening. Voting to approve the permit was granted by 3-0 vote after the initial motion and second was made followed by discussion.
