

Common Council – August 5, 2024

Council was called to order at 6:00 pm on the second floor of the city building. Live streamed on Youtube and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was given by clerk/treasurer-Julie Price. Members present: Kamron Yates, Spencer Kingery, Denny Myers, and Doyle Moore, and Cody Nelson. Erin Jubril was absent.


