

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM GRANT FUND (FUND #450)

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) provides states, territories, tribes, and local governments with critical funding necessary to support a range of law enforcement program areas; and

WHEREAS, the BJA has awarded the City of Delphi JAG funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Delphi Police Department requires the use of these monies received from the JAG Program, which requires a dedicated fund to receipt and disburse this allocation of grant money; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Delphi, Indiana, recognizes that a need now exists for the establishment of the JAG Program Grant Fund (Fund #450) pursuant to Indiana Code § 5-11, *et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Delphi, Indiana that:

Section 1. Fund Established. There is hereby established a fund to be known as the "JAG Program Grant Fund (Fund #450)" for the purpose of receiving and disbursing JAG funds awarded to the City of Delphi.

Section 2. Sources of Funding. The contributions to the Fund will be from the monies allocated to the City of Delphi from the JAG Program.


Section 3. Use of Funding. The City of Delphi shall only appropriate and use the funds for eligible purposes of the JAG Program.


Section 4. Termination and Balance Remaining. This Fund shall remain in existence until such time as the Common Council repeals the ordinance establishing said Fund. The disposition of any balance remaining in the Fund at the time of termination shall be determined by the Common Council.

Section 5. Perpetual Fund. The fund balance shall be perpetual until terminated by the terms of the current ordinance or by enactment of a subsequent ordinance.


Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
