

Common Council – September 3, 2024

Council was called to order at 6:00 pm on the second floor of the city building. Live streamed on Youtube and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was given by clerk/treasurer-Julie Price. Members present: Kamron Yates, Spencer Kingery, Denny Myers, Erin Jubril, Doyle Moore. Cody Nelson was late with arrival at 6:01pm after the pledge and roll call.

The minutes from the August 5, 2024 council meeting and August 27, 2024 Council budget workshop were presented for approval. There were no additions, subtractions, deletions, or amendments to the minutes. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Spencer Kingery, second by Erin Jubril. Motion carried and passed. (5-0)

Without objection, the department head reports were given to be submitted in to the minutes.

Other Business:

Council member Erin Jubril commented on public parking and the issues with Union St. and Franklin. After lengthy discussion and suggestions for possible solutions to parking issues including but not limited to, paid parking, parking passes or placards, removal of parking signs, etc. the council decided unanimously to enforce all parking throughout the downtown area and not just on select streets. Erin Jubril agreed to check in to pay parking as a solution possibility.

Mayor Yates announced possible road closures for the trunk or treat. Approval for parking for Franklin and Washington streets during the BOW meeting.

Miscellaneous Business:

Chief LaMar commented that the pre-trial parking for media ran smoothly and is hopeful that the same will occur for the trial in October.

Clerk/Treasurer Comments:




