

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 7

Ordinance Amending Title 7, Chapter 75, Schedule V, To Make South Union Street
Between East Main Street and Franklin Street (Northbound) a One-Way Street

WHEREAS, Title 7, Chapter 75, Schedule V, establishes one-way streets in the City of Delphi, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, residents of the City of Delphi and this Common Council request that this street be declared a one-way street to increase safety and protection of all who attempt to enter Main Street off of Union Street, due to poor sight lines and congested traffic;

WHEREAS, Council does not feel a four-way stop is practical to rectify this situation;

WHEREAS, the request is to amend and show that South Union Street between East Main Street and Franklin Street is now a one-way street headed northbound;

WHEREAS, the conversion of South Union Street to a one-way street northbound between East Main Street and Franklin Street would serve to reduce traffic on said street, would not negatively impact the ability of the public or school buses to access any business or residence, and would not negatively impact the ability of police, fire, or emergency services personnel to respond in the area.


WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELPHI:

1. Title 7, Chapter 75, Schedule V of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Delphi shall be amended to add South Union Street, between East Main Street and Franklin Street to the schedule of one-way streets as a northbound one-way street.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor. Resolved by the Common Council of the City of Delphi, Indiana this 14th day of June, 2021.


